

Asbestos Awareness for Architects and Designers

Asbestos is probably the most dangerous building material ever used.

Every year thousands of people fall ill and die due to asbestos exposure and it was widely used by the construction industry right up until the year 2000. The Control of Asbestos Regulations (CAR) apply to employers, employees, self-employed persons and duty holders and cover all work with asbestos-containing materials.

Regulation 10 of CAR states that every employer must ensure that adequate information, instruction and training is given to employees who are liable to be exposed to asbestos. The course includes an additional module aimed specifically at architects and designers working with buildings that may contain asbestos.

It also covers the risks of working with asbestos, recognises asbestos-containing materials, raises awareness in areas of use, steps to minimise the risks and introduces legislation that applies to working with asbestos.
