

# Assessing Display Screen Equipment

What is display screen equipment?

Display screen equipment are computer monitors, laptops, tablet PCs, televisions, smartphones, CNC control pads, portable diagnostic screens or equipment containing cathode ray tubes, or CRTs.

This course is aimed at users of display screen equipment (DSE) and anyone responsible for assessing display screen equipment. A 'user', is anyone who frequently uses display screen equipment for a significant part of their work day. If you use display screen equipment continuously for more than one hour a day, then you are classified as a 'user'.

The Health and Safety (Display Screen Equipment) Regulations designate special directives covering DSE safety. Both employers and employees are responsible for the safe use of DSE under the legislation. This course meets your statutory training obligations and introduces the right set-up and use of your DSE safely to minimise the risk of work-related injuries.
