The Construction Design and Management Regulations cover the management of health, safety and welfare.

Whatever your role in the construction industry these regulations are there to improve your health and safety. They are intended to ensure that projects are planned and run effectively and safely right from the start.

This awareness course covers the core concepts of the regulations and details the various roles required for a construction project along with the key documents that need to be produced. The course starts with an introduction to CDM, covers the parameters that need checking during project planning and presents several example projects that illustrate how the regulations can be applied.
