## Why is Infection Control important?

Infection prevention and control measures aim to ensure the protection of those who might be vulnerable to acquiring an infection. Every year at least 300,000 people develop a Health Care Associated Infection. This has a huge impact on the patient, the staff and the institution it occurs in.

This course starts by defining infection prevention and control and explains the impact of good and bad infection control. It further details the legislation that applies to infection control, different types of microorganisms, how bacteria are transmitted and the chain of infection.
