

Slips, Trips and Falls

Slips, trips and falls account for almost a third of non-fatal injuries at work.

A common misconception is that with a few changes to working practices and attitudes workplace injuries could be reduced significantly. This course introduces stats, and the law related to slips, trips and falls, and shows real-life examples and practical steps to minimise incidents.

The course also indicates possible changes that can be implemented in most businesses to significantly reduce the risk of a slip, trip or fall occurring. The final module is aimed at the management perspective.

- Recognise that Slips, Trips and Falls are their hazards in the workplace
- Understand and apply current legislation and reflect on the duty of care between employer and employee

- Apply to safety management systems to help reduce risk and also recognise human impact as a cause
