

Working at Height

This awareness course is designed for anyone who works at height.

The term work at height applies to a wide range of situations. Ranging from working on platforms, ladders, scaffolds or stages to working alongside deep trenches. The crucial thing to be aware of is how far you can fall. 'Falls' doesn't just mean people falling from heights.

Materials or equipment falls present an equally dangerous hazard. All working at height situations are covered by health and safety legislation - Work at Height Regulations 2005. These regulations confer legal duties on employers and employees to assess, control and minimise risks and hazards from work at height.

This course covers topics including the dangers of working at height, the regulations, the hierarchy of controls and assessing risk.

Please note this is an awareness course. If your duties include daily or frequent activity working at height further practical training is advised.
